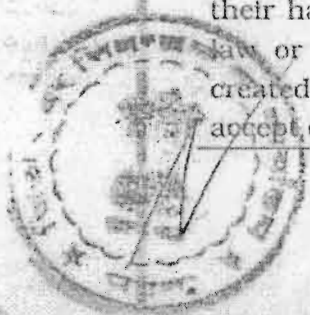

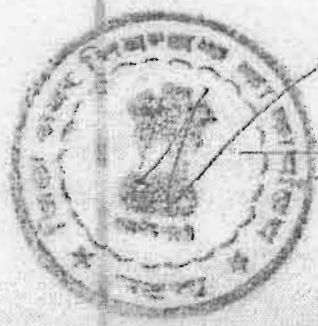

2. The Trust has commenced from 18th September 2012
3. The registered office of the Trust shall be located at the permanent address of Mr. Nadim Ahmad S/O of Mr. Mohammad Murtaza Ahmad, at New Azimabad Colony, Near R.K. Colony, Post Office Mahendru, P.S. Bahadurpur, Patna.800006. However, the registered office of the trust might move to other address anywhere in India depending upon needs and requirements, and

Any other institution operating under the trust shall be free to chose it's head/branch office at any location anywhere in India considering the interest of the beneficiary of the institution.

4. The Settlor of the trust has on this day transferred and given up to the Trustees a sum of Rs. 50000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only) to be held upon trust together with all the income arising there and all the accumulations and accretions thereto for the intent and purpose and objects herein contained:

5. AIMS & OBJECTS:-

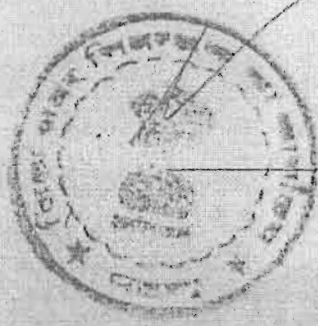
The aims and objects of the Trust shall be as follows:

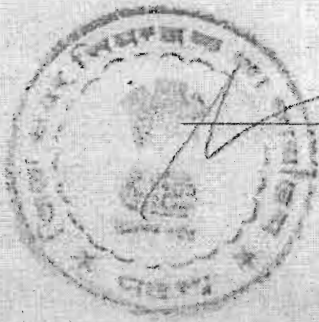
(b) The Lifetime Trustees shall hold office all through their lifetime. In case of death of a lifetime member, the life time membership of the expired member will be automatically transferred to the wife of the expired member.

(c) The minimum number of Lifetime Trustees shall be 2 (two) and the maximum shall be 5 (five).

(d) The Lifetime Trustees in future shall be inducted and appointed by the Lifetime Trustees only by majority vote.

(e) Only Lifetime Trustees will have voting right in Board of the Trustees and any decision taken by them by majority vote shall be final and binding. Other Trustees might be invited to board meetings but will not have any voting right.

(f) Any new Lifetime Trustees will be nominated by The Chairman of the Trust recommended by the Life Time Members by majority vote. The Chairman will hold the position for a period of two (2) years and is eligible for re-appointment any number of times by a majority of the Lifetime members, provided that in case of a tie the casting vote shall be cast by the oldest appointed life time member still serving as trustee and in case there be more than one such member then the casting vote shall

be of such a member who is elder in age. The system will be followed for any resolution and decision brought under discussion of the board of the Trustees. In case of any lifetime member not present in a board meeting, only the number of lifetime members present in the board meeting will be considered good enough to vote and in case of a tie, chairman's vote will be considered equivalent to two votes.

(B) ORDINARY TRUSTEES.

- (a) The Chairman of the Trust may nominate Ordinary Trustees from time to time.
- (b) The Ordinary Trustee shall retire by rotation in every 2 (two) years and shall be eligible for reappointment.
- (c) The ordinary Trustee shall have no voting right but will be invited for board meetings.
- (d) The number of Ordinary Trustees shall not ever exceed 6(Six).

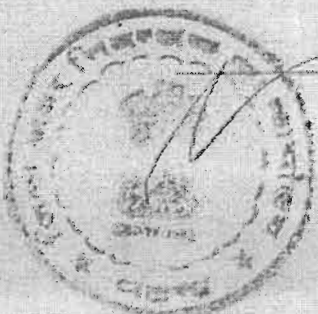
- (a) The Chairman of the Trust may nominate Contributory Trustees / Patrons from time to time. Their selection will be done by value of their support to the trust for implementation of its objects. They will be invited in board meetings but will have no voting rights.
- (b) The Contributory Trustees / Patrons shall retire by rotation every two (2) years and shall be eligible for reappointment.

10. BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

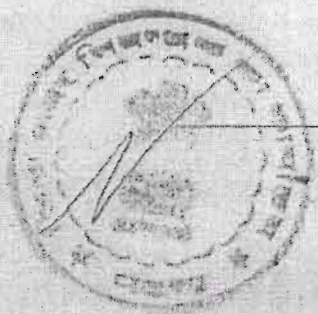
- (a) The Lifetime Trustees and the Ordinary Trustees shall constitute the Board of Trustees.
- (b) The total number of Lifetime Trustees and Ordinary Trustees shall not exceed 11 (eleven).
- (c) The Board of Trustees comprising of the Lifetime Trustees only shall vote by majority, on all matters of the Trust and the Chairman of the Trust shall have the voting right at par with other lifetime members. In case of any tie, the chairman's vote will be considered equivalent to two votes.
- (d) The Contributory Trustees / Patrons shall not be counted as in the total of Trustees but shall attend the meeting of the Board of Trustees if invited for the same.
- (e) A Trustee shall cease to be a Trustee, if
 - i). He/She declares insolvency.
 - ii). He/She resigns; or
 - iii). The period of his/her appointment expires in case he/she had been appointed for a fixed period;
 - iv). He/She leaves the country permanently.

Notwithstanding what has been stated in these clauses, any of the Trustees may retire after giving a calendar month's notice in writing of his / her

intention to do so to each of the other Trustees for the time being and upon expiry of the notice period, the Trustees giving such notice shall cease to be Trustees of the Trust.

- (f) A Trustee shall be deemed to have accepted office as Trustee if he has given his consent to the board of trustees for the same in writing.
- (g) The Trust Estate shall rest and remain vested in the Trust, even if for certain reasons it's title has temporarily been transferred in the name of anyone or more of the Trustees.

10. CHAIRMAN OF THE TRUST:

Chairman of the trust will be the chief Mentor of the trust and the trustees and shall guide, supervise and direct all the activities of the trust. He shall preside over the board meetings and shall be provided with facilities to fulfill his responsibilities for the accomplishment of the aims and objects of the trust upon approval of board of trustees. He will have authority to make payment by a single cheque to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- to anyone against request for assistance or against bills. In case the value of the Cheques is over Rs 20,000 it must be signed by the chairman as well as the Director of the trust. Any payment thus released must be approved by the board of trustees in their subsequent meeting.

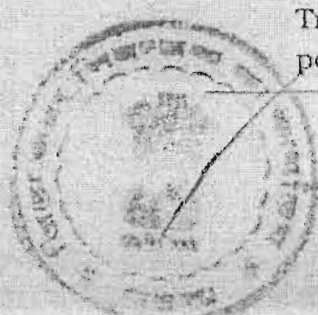
11. DIRECTOR OF THE TRUST.

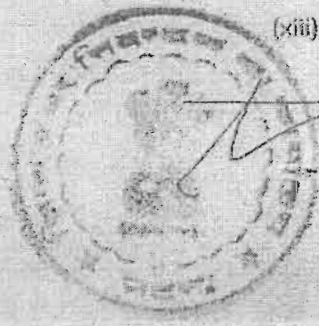


- (i) To do all act required for or be conducive to the attainment of the object of the Trust.
- (ii) To call board Annual, Monthly, Special and Emergency board meetings as per need.
- (iii) To employ administrative staff and other employees as well as agents, bankers, lawyers, accountants and others on such remuneration as he thinks fit.
- (iv) To be custodian of all records of the trust.
- (v) To be representative of the trust in all legal matters. He will also have authority to represent the trust in case of violation of right of the trust by others and in case one has to sue the trust for any claim.
- (vi) He will have the authority to implement rules and guidelines issued by government or other competent authorities.
- (vii) To withdraw any power or revoke any appointment of any employee or person working for the trust for financial benefit.
- (viii) To appoint committees and persons including employees and staff members of the Trust and to supervise activities and to terminate such appointments.
- (ix) To make payment against bills or advance of up-to Rs 100,000 to a single beneficiary without prior approval of the board. In case the value of the Cheques is over Rs 20,000 it must be signed by the chairman as well as the Director of the trust. Any payment thus released must be approved by the board of trustees in their subsequent meeting.
- (x) To transfer funds between the accounts of institutions running under the trust and main bank accounts of the trust and vice versa upon approval of the board of trustees.
- (xi) To design and fix Fee Structure of Educational Institutions operating under trust.
- (xii) To take loans with or without mortgaging the property of the trust for fulfillment of the any object of the trust.
- (xiii) To maintain income and expenditure of the trust and it's institutions.

- (xiv) To prepare annual performance and evolution report to be presented to the board of trustees in annual meeting and to make budget of the all institutions operating under trust. He may take help of any salaried employee of the trust or any institution of the trust to accomplish this task.
- (xv) To nominate executive committee of the institutions operating under the trust.
- (xvi) To form management committee of institutions operating under the trust upon recommendation of board of trustees.
- (xvii) Will be custodian of all cash, cheques, Bank Drafts and pass books of the trust. He may employ a salaried accountant to help him in carrying this responsibility.
- (xviii) To hire a reputed audit firm to do the financial audit of accounts books of the trust and its institutions which shall be presented to the board of trustees in annual meeting.
- (xix) To apply for, collect, recover, receive, and utilize any type of grant from any government, private or other sources to fulfill the aim and object of the trust as explained earlier.
- (xx) To recommend to the board of trustees in its annual meeting, the proper fund and its source for making repayment of any loan, which the trust or its institution might have utilized previously for achieving the aims and objects as explained earlier.
- (xxi) To keep and maintain a cash balance of Rs 20,000 as petty cash for maintaining day to day expenses of the trust which shall be reimbursed every month.

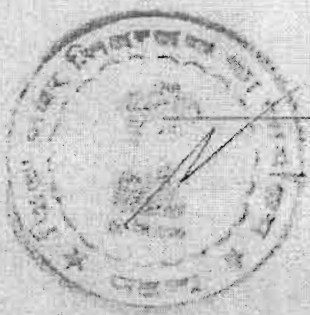

12. BANKING GUIDELINES:

- i) The Director of the Trust shall open Bank Account(s) in the name of the Trust upon instruction of Chairman in writing (letter, Internal Memo or email), where in all money payable to and receivable by the trust by virtue of these presents shall be kept and maintained.

- ii) All cheques with a value of more than Rs 20,000 must jointly be signed by Chairman as well as Director of the trust to be acceptable to the banks. However a cheque having of the value of Rs 19999 or less can be issued by individual signature of the Director of trust.
 - iii) The Director of the trust as well as the chairman will only be authorized to make payments to anyone and all cheques where the value is more than Rs. 20,000 shall bear signature of both of them on cheque leaf. For any amount less than that signature of Director or Chairman of the trust shall be considered sufficient to carry on transaction. For any mode of payment other than cheques, the banking document must be signed by Chairman as well as the Director of the trust.

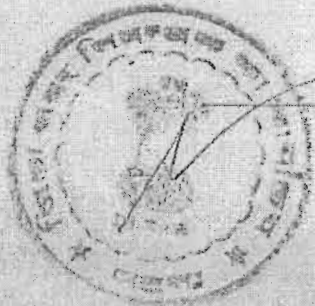
13. OTHER GENERAL RULES:

- i) Any Ordinary Trustee who becomes lunatic, convict of criminal offence involving moral turpitude, or neglects to take interest in executing responsibilities given to him by the trust, or abstains continuously for a period of more than six months or does not attend 3 board meetings regularly for which invitation has been issued to him/her, or is physically incapacitated shall cease to be the Trustee of the Trust.
- ii) Any Trustees may retire on giving notice of one calendar month in writing by registered/Speed Post of his / her intention to do so.
- iii) The Life Time Trustees may reimburse themselves or pay and discharge out of the said Trust properties all expenses incurred in or for the execution of the objects of the Trust and exercise of the powers vested in them subject to the approval by board of the trustees.

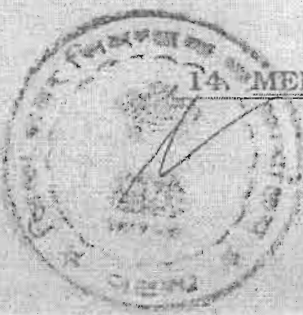

- iv) The board of the trustees will be authorized to allot vehicles under ownership of the trust to any member of board of trustees for execution of the member's responsibilities. Any expenses related to vehicle will be responsibility of the trust and it running cost will be reimbursed to the Trustee by the board of Trustees.
- v) At the end of each financial year, 75% of surplus fund available in the accounts of any institution operating under the trust shall be transferred to the bank account of the trust to enable trust to keep on fulfilling other objects and social obligations as explained earlier.
- vi) The Trustees and all the institutions, academic or otherwise are fully indemnified against expenses and losses incurred or suffered or any payments made by them in the administration of the Trust. Such expenses, losses and payments shall be borne by the Trust and none of the Trustees or the institution shall be personally liable or responsible for the same.
- vii) Not withstanding anything herein contained, the Trustees including the Director of the Trust shall not be liable in any manner for anything done by them bona-fide or for attainment of the objects of the Trust.
- viii) If at any time any Trustees act as full time office bearer of the Trust or renders any special services, the Board of Trustees may at their discretion pay reasonable remuneration or allowances to the trustee.
- ix) All deeds and other documents to be executed by or on behalf of the Trust shall be done by the Director of Trust.
